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HOW MANY WEEKS EACH YEAR CAN A JUMP CREW MEMBER WORK?

Depending on the area and how many shows there are, between 12 and 30 weeks per year.

WHAT IS THE PAY RANGE FOR JUMP CREW?

Between \$100 - \$200 per day, depending on experience.

WHAT ARE THE LEVELS (OR ARE THERE LEVELS) TO BEING JUMP CREW?

There are no real levels of jump crew, but there is an amount of respect for the more experienced crew, for the certain amount of knowledge has been acquired.

WHAT IS THE PROCESS TO BECOME JUMP CREW?

If you are healthy, strong, smart and hard-working, you simply need to apply for a job. The rest is learned on the job.

WHAT IS THE FIRST STEP SOMEONE WOULD TAKE TO BECOME JUMP CREW?

Apply wherever a show needs jump crew. Then, buy a tape measure and learn how to read it!

WHAT ARE THE PROS AND CONS TO BEING JUMP CREW?

Pros - good money, usually a nice work environment, get to meet a lot of new people.

Cons - Long hours, potentially bad weather (that doesn't stop or delay the job being done), getting yelled at by riders!
